The CAP University Prize Examination is a nation-wide competition among undergraduates studying physics. The Educational Trust Fund of the Canadian Association of Physicists provides a first prize, the Lloyd G. Elliott Prize, of \$500, a second prize of \$250, and a third prize of \$125. In addition, the winner of the first prize receives an all-expenses-paid trip to the CAP's Annual Congress to receive his/her prize at the banquet. All undergraduate students are encouraged to take this exam, and as further encouragement, the Physics & Astronomy Department will award **\$500** to each U.B.C. student who places in the **top ten nationally**.

Last year, one UBC undergraduate ranked **5th** in this competition between 24 universities!

We encourage talented students in any year of study to participate. There will be practice sessions in January where we will discuss some problems from previous exams
